Donations from *Giving Tuesday* at Holy Cross Church will be used towards painting the exterior of the church as well as outside work that needs to be completed on the Shrine of the Three Crosses. Our goal is to collect \$3,000. Please consider a donation towards the work to focus on our parish facilities. Scan the QR Code or visit daytonxii.org to make your donation online. At Our Lady of the Rosary Church, we would like to have the donations from *Giving Tuesday* go towards modifying the stalls and installing wheelchair ramps for the bathrooms in Shumaker Hall. Our goal is to collect \$10,000. Scan the QR Code or visit daytonxii.org to make your donation online. At St. Christopher Church, we would like to focus on our parish facilities with the restrooms in the church as one of the main issues for *Giving Tuesday*. We would like to redo the floors and sinks, which currently are original to the building. Other areas of concern are the holes in the parking lots, the wall by the gym, and the windows in the cafeteria by the steps, which are rusting out due to the weathering over the years. All these areas of concern need to be looked at and taken care of.

We currently have \$20,945 in our capital fund budget to get started on a few of these items, but as most of you know with the age of our buildings, this fund goes quickly. Our goal for this year is \$50,000, and all proceeds will go towards the improvement of our facilities. Donations can be made online, in the collection tower, or mail or drop off checks to the Parish Office.



Donations for *Giving Tuesday* at St. John the Baptist Church will be earmarked to the Building and Grounds Fund, which will be used as needed for future repairs of the building such as HVAC equipment, roofs, restroom upgrades, driveway repair, emergency repairs, and lighting to name a few. In September 2022, we replaced the roof over the banquet hall, offices, and classrooms at a cost of \$61,564. These funds came from the Building and Grounds Fund, which depleted the fund considerably. The current balance in our Building and Grounds Fund is \$27,204.12.

Our church was completed in 1998 and the addition was completed in 2005. The time is coming for the replacement of the ten HVAC units, which have an estimated cost of \$300,000 plus. This is one of the most urgent financial needs of our parish. Our goal this year is \$30,000 and all of the proceeds will go to the Building and Grounds Fund. Donations can be made online or simply mail or drop off checks to the Parish Office.



For *Giving Tuesday* at St. Peter Church, all donations will be split between two projects. The first is the upgrading of security cameras for St. Peter School. This project has been quoted at \$20,596, with a monthly monitoring fee of \$120. The second project is the refrigerator and freezer in the Food Pantry. The project began before COVID; the donations will help offset the increase in cost due to inflation and increase in material costs during COVID. Difference between initial quote and actual cost was \$20,000.
